*CanSkate is a learn-to-skate program for skaters who are 4+ years old as of Oct.1 the year of registration **or** have done the BSC Spring PreSchool session. Skaters are grouped by age and level with a maximum of 10 skaters per group. Groups are led by trained program assistants and coached by Skate Canada Professional Coaches. Instruction is in a group format (one-on-one lessons are not available at this level). **Registered skaters must wear a certified hockey helmet. Cages are required for beginner to Stage 3 skaters. Hockey or figure skates are permitted.***
