CURRENT MEMBER REGISTRATION: Monday, Mar.18 at 10am

Current member: A skater (or sibling of) currently registered with BSC & have the current member registration code

WAITLIST MEMBER REGISTRATION: Wednesday, Mar. 20 at 10am

Waitlist members: Any skater on the Fall/Winter 2023-2024 waitlist & have the waitlist member registration code

NEW MEMBER REGISTRATION: Friday, Mar.22 at 10am

New members: Any skater not registered with BSC for the Fall/Winter 2023-2024 season and not on the Fall/Winter 2023-2024 waitlist

REGISTRATION CODES: Registration codes are needed for CURRENT & WAITLIST members to register. These codes will be mailed to each of these groups prior to their registration windows

ALL NEW CANSKATE MEMBERS START IN PRECANSKATE.

New skaters are tested on day 1 and moved to a higher level group if appropriate.

Skaters must be 3+ years old as of Apr.1 the year of registration

Groupings: Groups are done based on age and level. All groups are checked on day 1 and skaters are moved if needed. CanSkate sessions are group format and NOT one-on-one. If your skater has an adaptation that requires one-on-one attention please email Becky at bedfordskatingclub@hotmail.com BEFORE registering.

Preschool CanSkate: Skaters must be 3- or 4-years-old as of Apr.1, 2024 to register. The focus about getting skaters comfortable on the ice. Pre/CanSkate

levels will be assessed but the on-ice format is not in circuit format. Experience is not required.

PreCanSkate/CanSkate: All new skaters start in PreCanSkate while also working on Stage 1 skills. No experience is required for new skaters. If your skater is new to the club but has more in-depth skating experience (i.e. hockey, speed skating, or weekly public skating), please email Becky at bedfordskatingclub@hotmail.com.

Teen: Skaters must be 12+-years-old as of Apr.1, 2024. Experience is not necessary.

Beginner/Intermediate Adult: Skaters must be 20+-years old as of Apr.1, 2024 and should have minimal to no experience.

Payment: All payment must be made online. All sessions can be paid in 2 installments by selecting the option when completing registration - the first due at registration and the second May 1.

All new member registrations will include a \$58.65 Skate Canada fee that will be added to registration when checking out.

Dressing rooms: Dressing rooms will be available but space is **very** limited. **Only use your assigned dressing room!** Skaters are encouraged to arrive ice ready.

Report cards: Report cards will be posted to your BSC account within 2 weeks of the end of the season.

Volunteers needed: Volunteers are the key to our success. We have roles open as "Rink Parent" during CanSkate sessions and roles on the board. If you are interested in volunteering off-ice in any capacity please email Becky at bedfordskatingclub@hotmail.com.

PRESCHOOL/PRECANSKATE/CANSKATE

PreSchool - New skaters 3- or 4-years-old as of Apr.1, 2024
CanSkate - PreCanSkate-Stage 6 experience from a Skate Canada program

Registration codes are required for Returning and Waitlist members. These codes will be sent by email.

New members will not need a code.

CanSkate is a learn-to-skate program. Skaters are grouped by age and level with a maximum of 10 skaters per group. Groups are led by trained program assistants and coached by Skate Canada Professional Coaches. Instruction is in a group format (one-on-one lessons are not available at this level).

Registered skaters must wear a certified hockey helmet. Face masks are required for beginner to Stage 3 skaters. Hockey or figure skates are permitted.

TEEN/BEGINNER & INTERMEDIATE ADULT

Teen CanSkate

- 12+ years old
- No experience required

All skaters must wear a CSA approved hockey helmet (no bike helmets). Face masks are strongly recommended for skaters under Stage 3. Hockey or figure skates are permitted.

Session is a mix of group and one-on-one check-in. Skaters should let coaches know if there are specific skills they want to work on (i.e. figure skating or hockey) for other activities.

Beginner/Intermediate Adult

- 20+ years old
- Little to no experience

All skaters must wear a CSA approved hockey helmet (no bike helmets). Hockey or figure skates are permitted.

Session is a mix of group and one-on-one check-in. Skaters should let coaches know if there are specific skills they want to work on (i.e. figure skating or hockey) for other activities.

CanSkate

- -4+-years-old
- -No experience needed
- -PreCanSkate Stage 6
- -Hockey or figure skates allowed

Club bridge program

PreAcademy

- -Must have invite
- -Stage 2-3 or approval
- -Encouraged to skate 2 days/week
- -Must start or switch to figure skates
- -Min. 80% attendance preceding season
- -Includes off-ice

Junior Academy

- -Must have invite
- -Stage 4+ or approval
- -Must skate 2 days/week
- -Must wear figure skates
- -Min. 80% attendance preceding season
- -Includes off-ice
- -Includes Stroking class w/ Bronze

Club organized Skate Canada program

STARSkate Bronze

- -Star 1-3 assessments
- -and/or no axel
- -Private/semi-private lessons w/ chosen coach
- Must have approval

STARSkate Silver

- -Passed a minimum of 2 Star 3+ assessments
- Competing Star 4-6/PreJuvenile
- -Private/semi-private lessons w/ chosen coach
- Must have approval

STARSkate Gold

- -Passed a minimum of 2 Star 6+ assessments
- -Competing Star 6+/Juvenile+
- -Private/semi-private lessons w/ chosen coach

Synchronized Skating

- -Must be Bronze+
- -No synchro experience needed
- -Encouraged to do at least 1 individual session

Adults

- -Adult synchro (figure skating experience required)
- -Adult singles (beginner, intermediate and advanced) *Levels vary by season based on available ice and coaching
